





How to draw a maze ~~~




1. Draw a border with a start & finish.




a. LIGHTLY pencil a winding path.




3. LIGHTLY pencil a bunch of dead ends.

5. Erase your paths.





6. Test & share your your sweeeet maze.


Optional: Trace over the included grid sheets for even paths.
