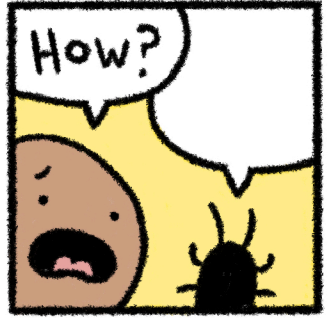




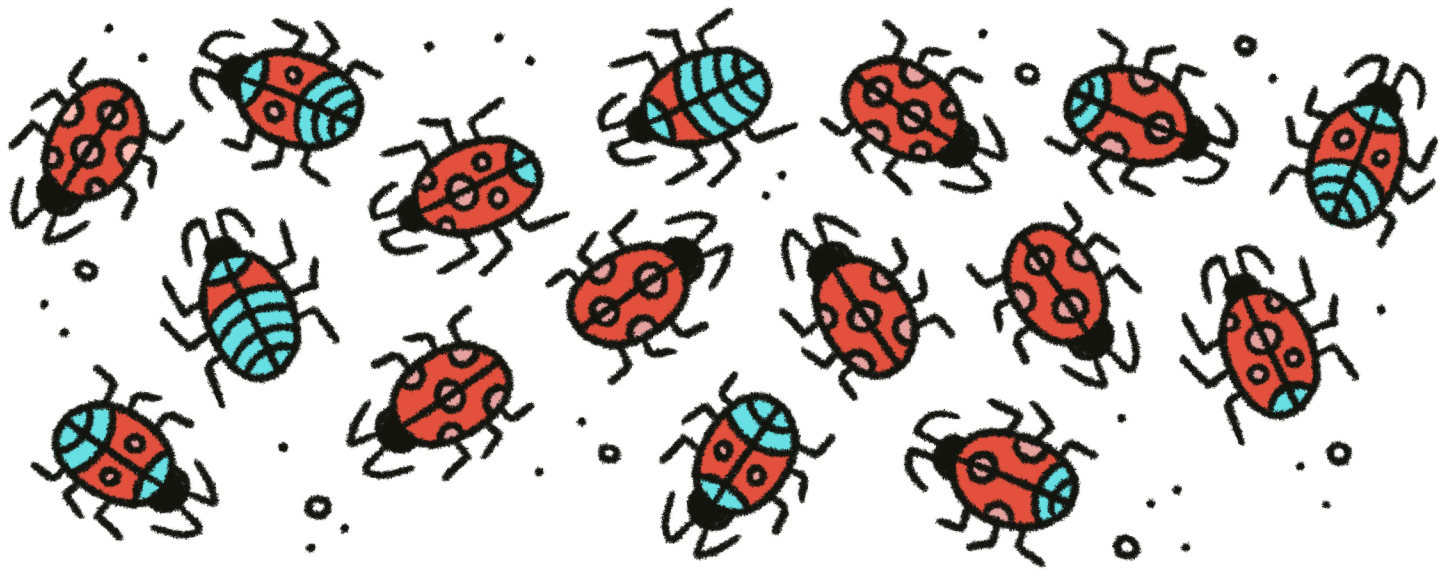

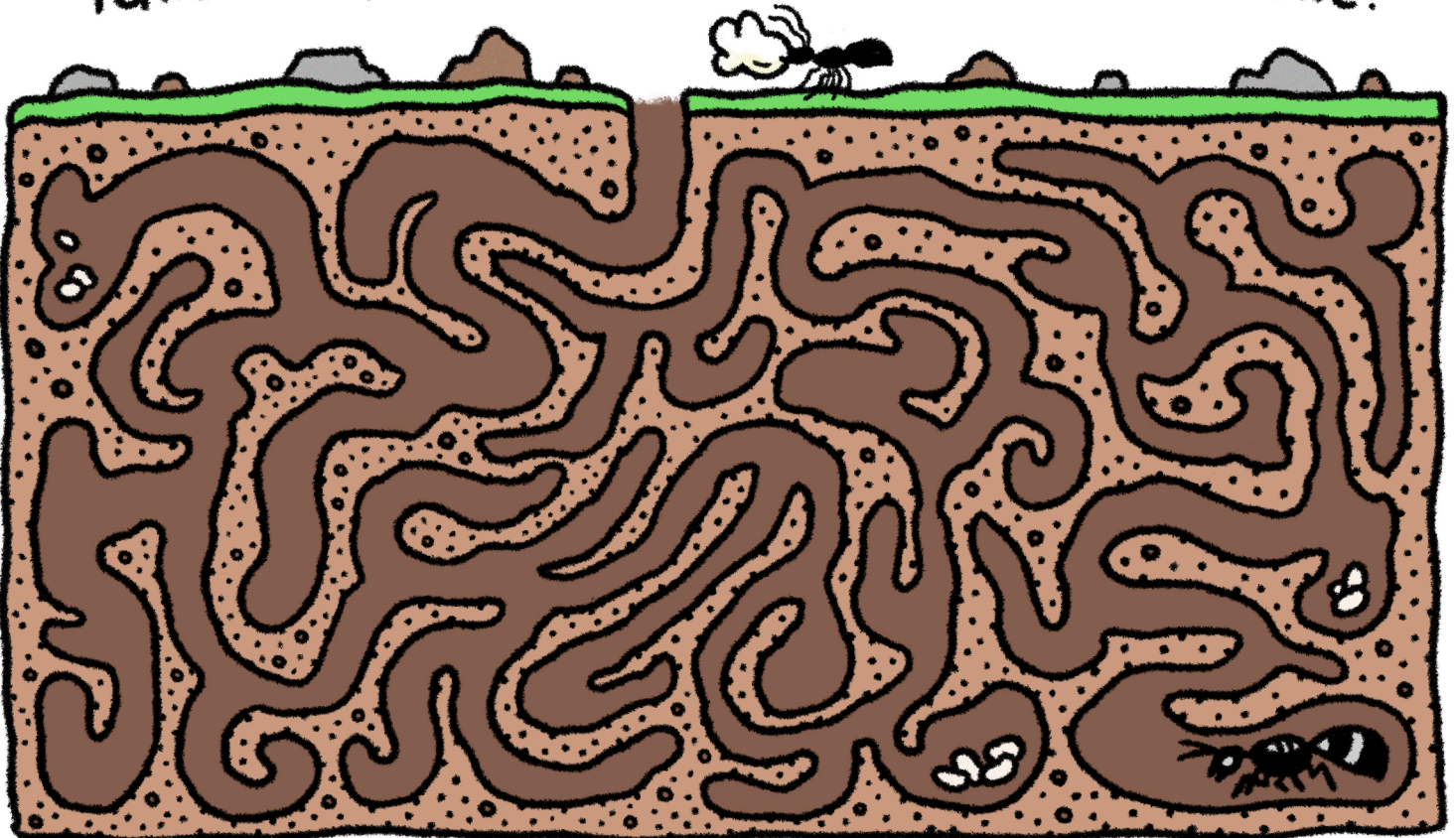


WORM FIND! Find the bug names in the puzzle below. Each letter is only used once. No diagonals.

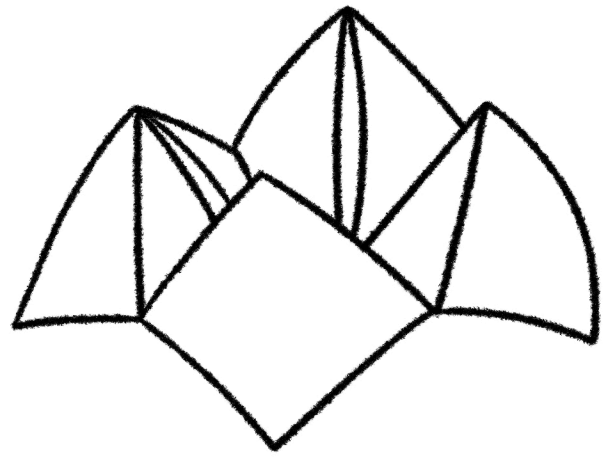

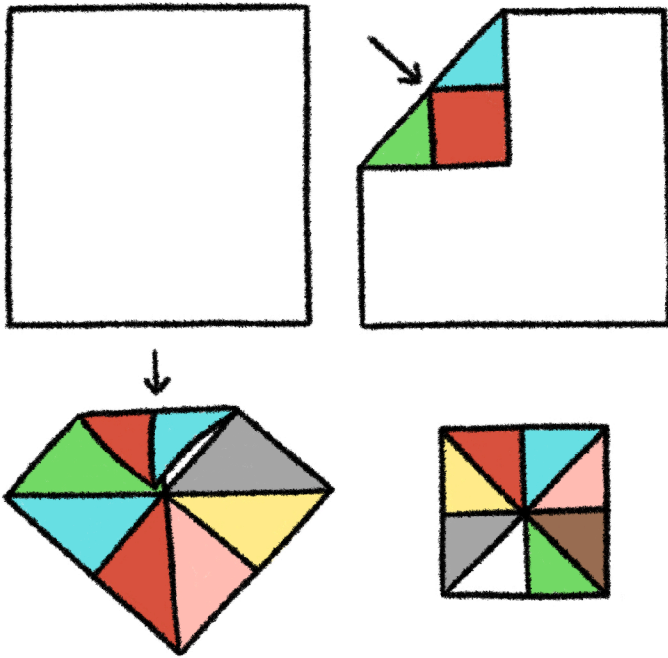
MADAM MANTISSA

1. Cut out your fortune-teller.
2. Put it face down.
3. Fold each corner to the center point of the square.
4. Flip the sheet over.
5. Fold each corner to the center point of the square.
6. Poof out the finger holders.

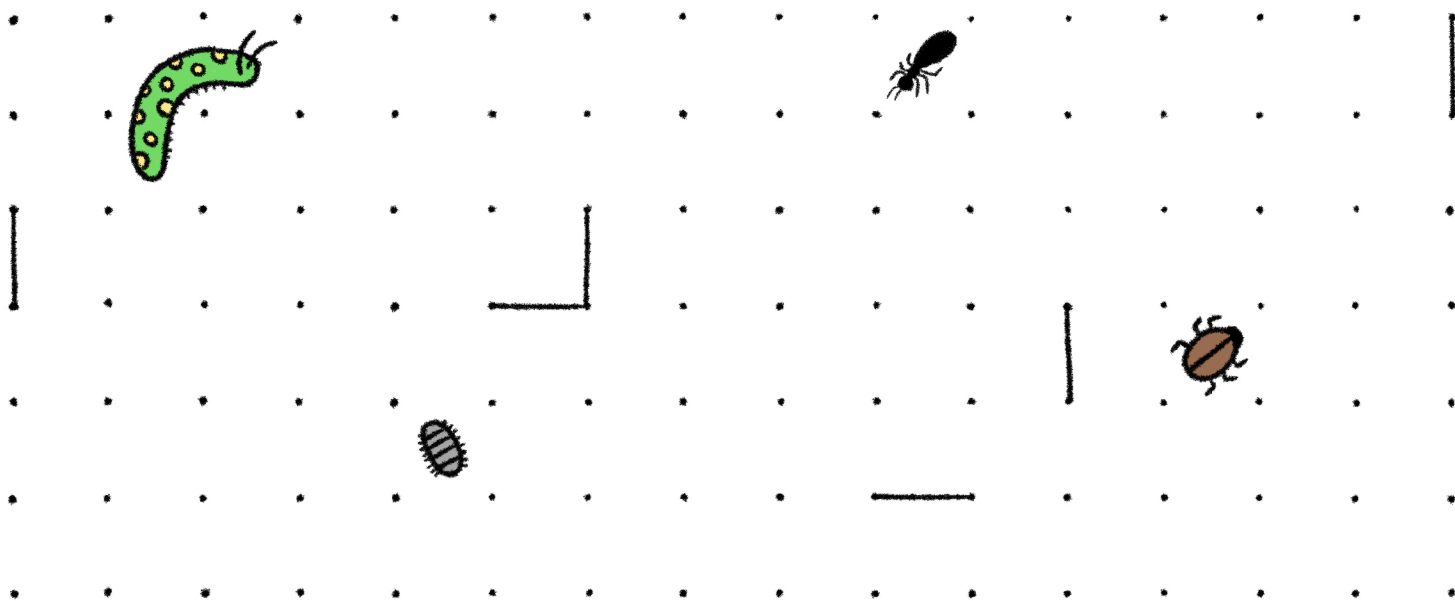

ITTY BITTY BUGGY CHALLENGE

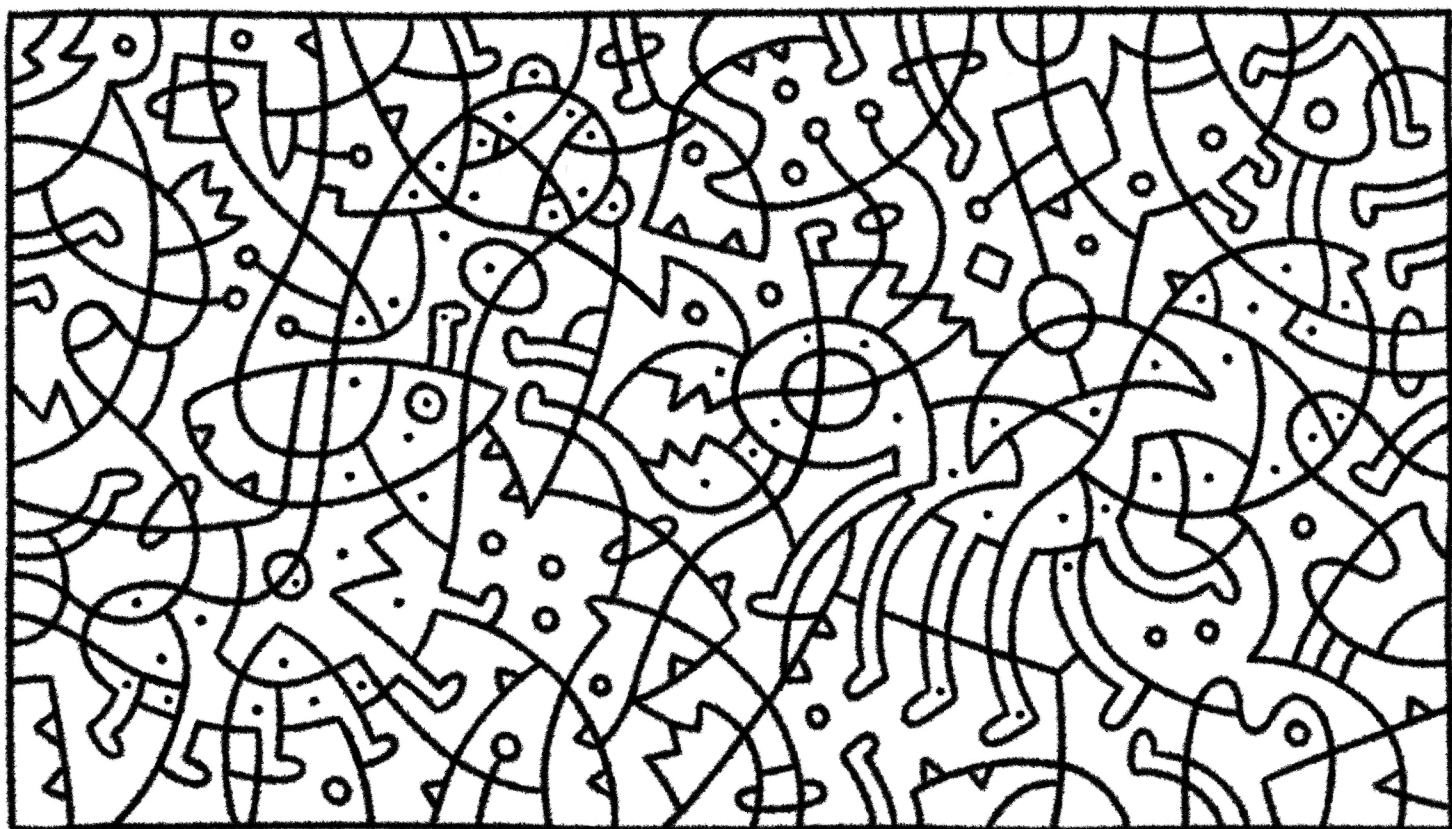
How many teeny tiny critters can you fit in the space below?
